

Athletic Eligibility Academic Policy

In order to be eligible for extra curricular activity, including athletics, the following requirements must be met.

1. The student must maintain an overall "C" (2.0) average from the previous grading period. Progress reports are guidelines reports only and aren't considered a grading period. The average is computed by letter grade only, not numerical.
2. The student can't have an "F" in a core subject, these include: History, Math, Science, English, and Bible.
3. Courses failed during the fourth quarter of one year can't be replaced with summer school grades the first quarter of the next year.
4. A "U" in conduct is not acceptable and will result in athletic/extra-curricular activity for an unspecified period of time.
5. Any incomplete will be counted as an "F" until that grade is completed.
6. Students may appeal suspensions to the Athletic Director first. Any suspension removed must be approved by the Administrator through the Athletic Director.
7. 1st Quarter eligibility is based on your 4th Quarter grades from the year before. If this happens a student will get a chance at a "fresh" start with a new school year. The student would have to be eligible at each grade sheet and progress report throughout the 1st Quarter. If at anytime the student would become ineligible then they would immediately be removed from the team (forfeit their \$50 play fee) and would not be eligible to play again until the 1st Quarter report card.
