



Central Baptist Church COVID-19 Attendance Guidelines

The wearing of masks is optional and are not provided by the church.

****If you are uncomfortable with this, it would be in your best interest not to attend.**

- Please **do not enter the buildings** if any of the following apply to you:
 - If you have a temperature over 100 degrees
 - If you have a cough or shortness of breath
 - If you have lost your sense of taste or smell
 - If you have traveled outside of the U.S. in the past 30 days
 - If you are on chemotherapy or radiation treatment
 - Enter the buildings **at your risk** if any of the following apply to you:
 - Over the age of 60
 - Have a weakened or compromised immune system
 - Have a history of respiratory illness or disease
 - Please remember to follow social distancing guidelines
- **Out of respect for others we ask that you please observe the following guidelines. While you personally may not be concerned about distancing and touching, others will be. Your cooperation in this is appreciated.**

- **Remain at least 6 feet apart in all directions from others**
- A strict no-touching policy (no handshakes, hugs, etc.)
- Hand sanitizer will be available in the hallways and in the back of the auditorium.
- Where possible, doors will be propped open
- No paper bulletins will be available. All announcements will be available via physical mailings, e-mail, website and social media
- We ask for limited use of restrooms
- Drinking fountains will be closed, individual bottles of water will be available (coffee will not be served)

- Gospel literature for distribution will be available upon request
- Sections will be taped off for to adhere to distancing guidelines

- Trash receptacles will be placed outside of the restrooms. We encourage attendees to use a paper towel to open the restroom door when exiting the restroom and place your paper towel in the trash receptacle outside of the restroom.

- The church buildings will be sanitized with a cold fogger and disinfectant sprayers before each gathering.
